

CONFERENCE VENUE

REC2013 will take place at ISR-UC (Instituto de Sistemas e Robótica – Universidade de Coimbra), that is adjacent to the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering - Faculty of Science and Technology of the University of Coimbra, at Pólo II.

HOW TO GET HERE

Plane

To travel to Coimbra you should fly either to Lisboa or to Porto and then take a train or a bus. The International Airports of Lisbon and Porto have regular scheduled flights to and from all main European destinations as well as major world cities.

By Train

From Lisbon

You can get to Coimbra by train from the main station of *Lisboa-Oriente* (you can arrive there from the airport by metro, bus or taxi). The trip from *Lisboa-Oriente* to *Coimbra-B* station takes approximately 120 minutes and the price for the train ticket (*Alfa Pendular* or *Intercidades* trains) varies between 15,50€ and 31€.

From Porto (Oporto)

The trains leave from *Porto-Campanhã* station (you can get there from the airport by bus, taxi or metro - use the direct violet metro line from the *Sá Carneiro Airport*). The trip from *Porto-Campanhã* to *Coimbra-B* station takes approximately 60 minutes and the price for the train ticket (*Alfa Pendular* or *Intercidades* trains) varies between 11€ and 21,50€. By Bus

You can also arrive in Coimbra by Bus. Ticket prices are approximately 13€, coming from Lisbon, and 11,50€, coming from Porto. Detailed information can be found at <http://www.rede-expressos.pt>.

By car

Portugal has a good network of motorways/freeways. You can rent a car at the airport or at any train station as well as in all major cities.

- **By car, from the north of Portugal (Porto)**

Recommended exit from A1: *Coimbra-Sul*.

Follow *IC2* to Coimbra and then follow the signs indicating *IC2 Lisboa* to the bridge *Rainha Santa Isabel*. Exit from this bridge at the first exit and follow indications to *Universidade (Pólo II)*.

- **By car, from the south of Portugal (Lisbon)**

Recommended exit from A1: *Condeixa*. Follow IC2 to Coimbra and enter the bridge Rainha Santa Isabel. Exit from this bridge at the first exit and follow indications to *Universidade (Pólo II)*.

Arriving at the conference venue (Pólo II - Universidade de Coimbra), using city buses, from within Coimbra

You can arrive at the conference venue using public transports (yellow buses).Corresponding Bus lines to Pólo II are: 34 - *Universidade - Pólo II da Universidade* and 38 – *Planalto Sta. Clara (Fórum) - Pólo II da Universidade*. Timetables are available at <http://www.smtuc.pt/>.
